

Another Opportunity to Give

Hey, brothers and sisters! I hope you have been able to make the best use of your time in self-isolation.

Thanks to the diligent efforts of several of our brothers and sisters, our church now offers the option of online giving.

Here are a few circumstances in which you may find this opportunity beneficial:

1. You may choose to give online temporarily until we return together.
2. You may choose to make online giving your permanent preferred method of giving.
3. In the future, you may find online giving useful if you are sick at home or on vacation.

You may decide that online giving is not for you, and that's alright. During self-isolation, you still have the opportunity to drop your offering off at the church building or mail it in.

If you are interested in online giving, here is what you need to do: Visit our website, www.neoshochurchofchrist.org, and click on the "Give" tab in the top right corner. This can be done from your computer's or smart phone's web browser. From the giving page, you can enter your bank account number or credit/debit card. Online giving is similar to most other online transactions, so the process should feel straightforward and familiar. Hillcrest can issue refunds if you accidentally contribute beyond your means and will keep records of contributions for tax purposes as well.

From our website's giving page, you will have the option to make a one-time transaction or set up recurring transactions. Here are our recommendations for each option:

Recommendations for One-Time Giving

- Know that your personal information will not be saved unless you create an account.
- Understand there is a service fee for each transaction. There is a 1%+30¢ service fee for bank account transactions and a 2.7%+30¢ fee for credit/debit transactions. You have the option to cover the fees yourself or have the church pay the fee.

Recommendations for Recurring Giving

- Sign up to create a Tithe.ly account. It will be much easier to modify recurring transactions in the future with an account. When you have reached the giving page on our website, you can find the "Sign Up" button in the top right corner.
- Use your bank account for recurring giving. There is a 1%+30¢ service fee for bank account transactions as opposed to a 2.7%+30¢ fee for credit/debit transactions. You have the option to cover the fees yourself or have the church pay the fee.

Online giving is a convenience that does not change what scripture says or what we believe about giving as an act of worship. May we each continue in faithful stewardship, remembering the words of Paul in 2 Corinthians 9:6-8 (ESV). "(6) The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. (7) Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. (8) And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work."
