On Wednesday nights this fall, our 7th-12th grade youth group has been invited to ask any question that might have a Bible answer. Do you have some of the same questions?

- Why are there so many different religions?
  - Why do people sometimes die so young?
  - Why is using musical instruments in worship bad when the Bible says, "Praise him with trumpet sound..." (Psalm 150:3)? Isn't that praising with instruments?
  - Romans 13 tells us to obey the laws of the land, but if a government oversteps its bounds, are we still required to follow?
  - Is it wrong for a couple to live together before they are married?
  - Why do people think it's alright to have sex before marriage?
  - Is it wrong to drink if you don't get drunk?
  - Will people who lived in the time of the Old Law be saved the same way as us today?
  - If Adam and Eve never sinned, would people never die? Would we even be alive today?
  - Is killing people ok if you're in the army? When is the line drawn?
  - Why are there divisions in the church of Christ? Specifically why do some believe they should wear skirts and long hair, drink from one cup, etc.?
  - Is it ok to be friends with homosexuals?
  - Is chewing tobacco a sin?
  - Should you let your friends talk behind someone's back as long as you are not involved?
- Is it sinful to give up on God—like just losing your faith? Would you have to repent?
  - When were bacteria and viruses created?
  - If a woman is giving birth, and only the mom or the baby can survive, who gets to live, and who dies?
  - Should we tell someone of authority if someone is doing wrong all the time? Not major things but littler things like name calling and teasing.
  - How do we know when we're too focused on physical circumstances such as finances, relationships and hobbies?

In these Bible class discussions, before the teacher offers an answer, usually the question is turned back on the students: "What does the Bible say?" And most of the time, the students know right where to start in order to get to the bottom of the issue.

I'm encouraged that our kids are thinking and wrestling. The 21st century challenges their young lives. They are determined to know and live by the truth, and they are putting everything to the right test (Acts 17:11).

Thank you to the parents who are shaping these souls, for molding their hearts to love God and leading them to want to know and do what's right. Thank you to Bible class teachers and preachers who have systematically helped point them in the right direction all their lives.

The kids are still turning in questions. If we can't get them all answered before the quarter ends, we'll make some of them sermon themes in December.
