We decided that the best thing to do this year was to forego attending the national convention, and instead adapt and have our own convention right here at Hillcrest on Saturday, April, 3. We will have a full and fun day of spiritual activities and fellowship.

What can you do to help? First, please make plans to attend with us from 10 am to noon, where we will start the day with the young men giving speeches, leading singing, and reading from the Bible; the young ladies will then follow after them with their events. There is no better way to encourage these young people than by being there Saturday morning to support them. The kids and their families will then enjoy lunch together, followed with the Bible Bowl, and then games, fellowship, and even a service project off site before returning for a BBQ supper and an awards ceremony.

Second, please pray for the participants and L2L. Proverbs 22:6 tells us to "Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it." L2L is just one of the many, valuable ways to help parents accomplish this, and we desire to have a successful program for the remainder of the year.

The **elder-led family prayer** time on Thursday evening at 7:00 on Facebook Live will be led by Bill Reiboldt.




