- **Psalm 147:3** – “He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.”
- **Isaiah 53:4-6** – “...With his wounds we are healed...”
- **Isaiah 57:1-2** – The righteous man enters into peace.
- **John 14:1-6** – “Let not your hearts be troubled... I go to prepare a place for you...”
- **Romans 8:18** – “For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.”
- **Romans 8:35-39** – Nothing can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- **2 Corinthians 5:1** – “For we know that if the tent that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.”

- **Philippians 1:21-23** – To depart and be with Christ is far better.
- **Philippians 4:6-7** – “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”

- **1 Peter 1:3-7** – We are born again to a living hope.
- **1 Peter 5:6-7** – “...[Cast] all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.”
