The San Andreas fault on the west coast of America is a disaster waiting to happen. Researchers estimate a 7% chance that “The Big One,” a magnitude 8.0 earthquake, could occur within the next few decades. U.S. Geological Survey seismologist Ned Field says, “We think Southern California is locked and loaded, that the stresses have really built up, and when things start unleashing, they could unleash for years.” \$200,000,000,000 in damage, 50,000 injuries, and 2,000 deaths could be the cost of such an event.

In Hebrews 12, the inspired author warns us of the earth-shaking consequences for those who refuse to listen to God.

Hebrews 12:26–29 (ESV)

[26] At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, “Yet once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens.” [27] This phrase, “Yet once more,” indicates the removal of things that are shaken—that is, things that have been made—in order that the things that cannot be shaken may remain. [28] Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, [29] for our God is a consuming fire.

“The Big One” is coming. Most everything we know will be destroyed. One thing will persevere: the unshakable kingdom that God’s people have received.

If you’re a citizen of God’s kingdom, a member of the church, you have nothing to worry about! God is our refuge and strength (Psalm 46:1). We worship him with reverence and awe. The judgment is a day which we confidently face.

If you’re not a faithful Christian, heed the warnings of the inspired author. It’s a joy to be a child of God, but “It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.” (Hebrews 10:31)

“Everyone should live every day like it could be the day of the Big One, because any day, even today, could be that day.” – Ned Field, Seismologist
