October is the time of year when we see skeletons, ghosts, and other deathly images portrayed throughout our community. These portrayals are usually trivial and lighthearted. The Bible paints some terrifying pictures of death for disobedient children, and they should make your heart sink like a rock! The following Proverb is especially gut-wrenching.

Proverbs 30:17 (ESV)

The eye that mocks a father
and scorns to obey a mother
will be picked out by the ravens of the valley
and eaten by the vultures.

Remember the punishment for stubborn, rebellious, disobedient children under the old law.

Deuteronomy 21:18–21 (ESV)

[18] “If a man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey the voice of his father or the voice of his mother, and, though they discipline him, will not listen to them, [19] then his father and his mother shall take hold of him and bring him out to the elders of his city at the gate of the place where he lives, [20] and they shall say to the elders of his city, ‘This our son is stubborn and rebellious; he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton and a drunkard.’ [21] Then all the men of the city shall stone him to death with stones. So you shall purge the evil from your midst, and all Israel shall hear, and fear.

Though we’re not under the old law, the new law reiterates the connection between disobedient children and death.

Romans 1:29–30, 32 (ESV)

[29] They were filled with all manner of unrighteousness... [30] disobedient to parents... [32] Though they know God’s righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.

Praise be to God the Father who compassionately embraces his penitent children (Luke 10:20-24). Life is better for children who honor their parents (Ephesians 6:3). Life is best for children who obey God the Father!
