- Provoke one another in a good way (Heb. 10:24).
- Be devoted and prefer one another (Rom. 12:10).
- Edify one another (Rom. 14:19).
- Teach and admonish one another (Col. 3:16, Rom. 15:14).
- Forbear and forgive one another (Col. 3:13, Eph. 4:2).
- Comfort one another (1 Thess. 4:18).
- Consider one another (Heb. 10:24).
- Serve one another (1 Pet. 5:5).
- Receive one another (Rom. 15:7).
- Submit to one another (Eph. 5:21).

We should not...

- Deliver up one another (Matt. 24:10).
- Hate one another (Titus 3:3).
- Judge one another (Rom. 14:13).
- Bite and devour one another (Gal. 5:15).
- Be consumed of one another (Gal. 5:15).
- Provoke one another (Gal. 5:26).
- Envy one another (Gal. 5:26).
- Wrong one another (Lev. 25:17).
- Accuse one another (Acts 19:38).
- Slay one another (Rev. 6:4).
