Cognitive Warfare

False apostles had built a stronghold in the church at Corinth. They absolutely hated Paul and worked to erase his influence in the church. Even worse, they were leading people away from Christ. How did Paul respond? He was angry for certain! He felt a “divine jealousy” for the church as they were deceived. How could he break through the stronghold of false apostles to reach those who were genuinely seeking Christ? He answers in 2 Corinthians 10:3-5.

[3] For though we walk in the flesh, we are not waging war according to the flesh. [4] For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds. [5] We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ, (ESV)

How did the church at Corinth become a stronghold of false teaching? Larry Davenport, who spoke through video to the youth class last Wednesday, has identified the downward spiral of sin in 2 Corinthians 10:3-5. Sin starts with thoughts, then morphs into imagination, then finally becomes fortified as a stronghold.

Thoughts

Certainly, we are all confronted with thoughts of sin. We are tempted through our senses, or the tempter may send thoughts of wickedness to our minds. This is why we are commanded to take every thought captive! Replace deceptive thoughts with truth; meditate on God’s word. Praise him in song; surrender to him in prayer. Let God transform your mind.

Imaginations

If we fail to take them captive, thoughts capture our imagination (the KJV renders “arguments” in verse 5 as “imagination”). This is where attraction becomes lust. If we entertain our desires with sinful thoughts or argue to justify wickedness, we are in sin.

Strongholds

When our imaginations find a home within us, they harden our hearts into fortified strongholds. Nothing can free us from sinful fortifications apart from the power of God. This is why Paul equipped himself with the power of God to confront the stronghold of false teaching at Corinth.

Let’s capture our thoughts before they become sin. Let’s replace thoughts of temptation with Godly meditation. When strongholds of false teaching are built around us, let’s lean on the power of God to advance the Truth. When we build up strongholds of deception within ourselves, may God break our hearts and may he work through us for His good.
